The purpose of this letter is to amend our current NRC license to reflect the following changes. We are requesting a Transfer of Control amendment, and an additional location use. Please find the enclosed information pertaining to both matters enclosed.

Item #1: We are requesting a transfer of control of Dearborn Diagnostic Center, to Heart & Vascular Physicians. All equipment and sealed sources will be transferred upon approval of this amendment. We have included the required information for this transfer for your review.

Item #2: We request approval for an additional location of use for **Heart & Vascular Physicians**. The additional location of use address of use is listed below:

We have enclosed a diagram of the existing department for your review. Please note the following.

The facility is a multiple story structure. The area above and below the Nuclear Medicine suite is medical offices. There are no designated room numbers.

Areas of use will be restricted to the Injection Area, Treadmill Area, Imaging Area and Dose Prep Area.

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All radioactive materials will be received and stored in the
(Locked Cabinet) in the Hot Lab.


All waste and radioactive materials will be stored in Lead.

Access to all radioactive materials is controlled by lock and key.
Authorized personnel only have access to restricted areas and
radioactive materials.


The dimensions of the facility are on the diagram.

1. License No. 21-32562-01
2. Current name: Dearborn Diagnostic Center
3. The new name will be: Heart and Vascular Physicians

Transfer of stocks by sale will be made. Heart and Vascular Physicians will obtain possession of the nuclear medicine camera, all radiation safety equipment and all sealed sources for the following location:



5. All currently approved users and RSO will remain without change.
6. Dearborn Diagnostics will no longer operate once the transfer is complete. All nuclear medicine activities will be under Heart and Vascular Physicians, 21-32562-01.
7. All required records regarding the use and possession of licensed materials will be current at the time of the transfer. The status of compliance will be maintained before, during and after the merger. All of these records are maintained on site. NO records regarding licensed material will be removed from the licensed site.
8. All required documents and records are currently kept in accordance with the NRC license condition. These include, but are not limited to the annual calibration of survey instruments, semi-annual leak testing of non-exempt sealed radioactive sources, radiation monitoring and personnel exposure monitoring reports. Radiation monitoring is performed as required by the NRC licensee on a daily basis for acceptable radiation levels and weekly for removable contamination.
9. We confirm the areas of storage, preparation, handling, and administration of radioactive materials are surveyed daily for acceptable radiation levels and weekly for removable contamination. If contamination of these areas is detected during these daily or weekly surveys, decontamination is undertaken and completed at that time. The unsealed radionuclides in use at this location are all short-lived (i.e. half lives less than 65 days, most less than 10 days). Therefore, radioactive contamination is highly unlikely at this facility. If contamination were present, it would be discovered prior to the transfer. Record will be maintained on site of inventories of sealed sources and spills of radioactive materials.
10. Heart and Vascular Physicians agrees to abide by all commitments and representations previously made to the NRC by Dearborn Diagnostic Center

11. Heart and Vascular Physicians accepts full responsibility for the site. This facility is exempt from providing financial assurance for decommissioning because of the type of radioactive materials used (i.e. short-lived, unsealed sources in small quantities only). Routine radiation monitoring of the facility ensures that contamination will not be transferred during any subsequent change of ownership.

12. All parties involved with the transfer are aware and agree to the planned transfer of ownership.
