SUBJECT: REVISED NEW REACTOR LICENSING SCHEDULE FOR FEDERAL
EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY (FEMA) PLANNING PURPOSES

As discussed at the March 26, 2007, Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC)/Department of Homeland Security (DHS) New Reactors Working Group meeting, enclosed is an updated schedule of future new reactor licensing activities. This revision reflects the latest projected submittal dates based on information from prospective applicants and updates the information previously provided to DHS in our letter dated August 3, 2006.

Please note that the enclosed information is subject to change and we will forward to you any changes that become available to us.

NRC and DHS/FEMA share a common objective of protecting public health and safety through our efforts in evaluating emergency plans for proposed new reactor sites. As you are aware, we have been working closely with your staff to develop sound protocols and processes for our interactions during new reactor licensing activities.

We hope this information will be helpful to your planning and resource allocation efforts in support of new reactor licensing activities.
