As per our conversation today, I am requesting that our license #31-30650-01, for the use of radioiodine 131, be amended to remove the restriction of a 3-day stay for the treated cats. We will still require that cats not be released from our facility in Connecticut until the radiation reading at one meter from the cat has been reduced to 0.5 millirem per hour or less. Our experience in having treated and measured hundreds of cats has shown that a 3 day stay is usually not needed to achieve these levels.

I would also like to amend our license to allow the owner of these cats to have the option of flushing the waste products (feces and urine) using flushable litter; or collecting and holding the litter waste, then disposing the waste in the trash after 1 month, as we now instruct them to do.
