Dear Mr. Weber:

On January 30, 2007, USEC Inc. (USEC) provided a brief summary of the facility changes (made without prior U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff approval in accordance with 10 *Code of Federal Regulations* (CFR) 70.72) to the records required by 10 CFR 70.62(a)(2) for calendar year 2006 (Reference 1). On April 6, 2007, the NRC staff requested the following additional information on selected Facility Change Evaluations (FCE) made during the calendar year 2006 to verify the requirements of 10 CFR 70.72(c) were met (Reference 2):

- (1) The facility change package – which should detail the evaluation performed in accordance with 10 CFR 70.72(a);
- (2) Any other explanation on how the individual requirements of 10 CFR 70.72(c) were satisfied for each change performed; and
- (3) All related revisions to the requested FCE.

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

This information must be protected from disclosure per the requirements of 10 CFR Part 810. Enclosure 3 also contains Unclassified Controlled Nuclear Information; therefore, it must be protected from disclosure in accordance with 10 CFR Part 1017.
