Trish, I left you a couple VMs today; specifically there was a question on the March 1, 2009 delivery date. Obviously we will be ok for a couple years with the FDA expiration extension on the KI we have on-hand now. A March 1, 2009 delivery date / shipment of (hopefully) fresh KI should give us another 5 year (minimum) supply. If the KI supplier has a 7 year expiration date on that new material - even better.

The Department of Health on behalf of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania would like to accept the Nuclear Regulatory Commission's (NRC) offer to replenish the state supply of Potassium Iodide (KI).

The Commonwealth has an active Potassium Iodide program. As of January 1, 2007, there have been 950,866 KI tablets pre-distributed in Pennsylvania, representing 49.35% of the initial 1,926,960 KI tablets received from the NRC.

As information, the Commonwealth will also be accepting the FDA letter authorizing the shelf extension of the KI supply that is being held in environmentally controlled conditions. Current estimates indicate that the current supply of KI will last until approximately August of 2008.

The Commonwealth is requesting a replenishment of 2,200,000 tablets of the 130 mg Iosat® Tablets (Potassium Iodide Tablets USP) on March 1, 2009. If the 130 mg tablets are not available, the Department would request 4,400,000 tablets of the 65 mg Iosat® Tablets (Potassium Iodide Tablets USP).

In addition, the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania will be declining your offer of ThyroShield™ (KI Oral Solution, USP) 65mg/mL oral solution.

The Department of Health, on behalf of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, would like to accept the US Department of Health & Human Services, Food and Drug Administration's offer to extend the shelf life of the Pennsylvania Department of Health's controlled supply of Potassium Iodide (KI) by an additional 2 years.

The Department of Health has maintained the current supply of KI in environmentally controlled conditions. In addition, periodic tests of the KI supply have been conducted to ensure the viability of the current supply. As of January 1, 2007, there have been 950,866 KI tablets pre-distributed in Pennsylvania, representing 49.35% of the initial 1,926,960 KI tablets received from the NRC.

The current stock of 130 mg Iosat® Tablets (Potassium Iodide Tablets USP) have label expiration date of 8/2007. The lot numbers for the KI that are in stock are as follows: P200219, P200220 and P200222.

With the applied extension, the current KI supply will have an expiration date of 8/2009, and will be appropriately marked with the new expiration date prior to distribution to the general public or emergency preparedness workers. The Department of Health will also conduct several public announcements to educate the public of the shelf life extension and the expiration of the supplies that they have.
