NASA Langley Research Center (LaRC) has requested a modification to its broad scope license to allow the use of radioactive materials at temporary job sites. This work typically is conducted at government research facilities and US military bases and occasionally at corporate locations. The sources used are sealed sources, such as Kr-85 and Ni-63, used for aerosol analysis. Although these sources are generally licensed articles it has proven to be easier to get authorization to use these sources at these locations if our broad scope license reflects authorization to use radioactive materials at temporary job sites. The sources are maintained under the control of an employee of NASA LaRC at all times.
