Due to Prime Measurement Products pending sale of the company and possible break up of certain product lines, we are unable to commit to the actions and resources required for implementing positive corrective action steps.

Mr. Mark Larson, Manager of Nuclear and Government Product Engineering has left the company and Mr. Roger Krechmery, Director of Engineering has retired. This has left us short on the engineering support required to implement these corrective actions.

I would like to request a sixty-day extension until all of these issues can be resolved and the direction of the company and its nuclear product line is determined.
