We are enclosing a copy of Amendment No. 1 to our A.E.C. License Number SIB-527 which changes the quantities under Item 7 from the original license. We would like to have these quantities listed on your letter of March 26, 1971 to read as follows:

Two hundred thousand (200,000) pounds of metal or process sludge; ten thousand (10,000) pounds of oxide or fluoride; and six hundred (600) pounds of compounds.


