Gentlemen:

This refers to the routine safety inspection conducted by Mr. G. L. Shear of this office on March 21, 1985, of activities authorized by NRC Source Material License No. STB-1097 and to the discussion of our findings with you and other members of the Consolidated Aluminum Corporation staff at the conclusion of the inspection.

The inspection was an examination of activities conducted under your license as they relate to radiation safety and to compliance with the Commission's rules and regulations and with the conditions of your license. The inspection consisted of a selective examination of procedures and representative records, observations, independent measurements, and interviews with personnel.

During this inspection, certain of your activities appeared to be in non-compliance with NRC requirements, as specified in the enclosed Appendix. A written response is required.

The responses directed by this letter (and the accompanying Notice) are not subject to the clearance procedures of the Office of Management and Budget as required by the Paperwork Reduction Act of 1980, PL 96-511.

NOTICE OF VIOLATION

License No. STB-1097

As a result of the inspection conducted on March 21, 1985, and in accordance with the General Policy and Procedures for NRC Enforcement Actions, (10 CFR Part 2, Appendix C), the following violation was identified:

License Condition No. 12 states that licensed material shall be used by, or under the supervision of, a named individual.


Contrary to the above, licensed material is no longer used by, or under the supervision of the named individual. Licensed material is being used by persons not authorized by the license.

This is a Severity Level IV violation (Supplement VI).

Pursuant to the provisions of 10 CFR 2.201, you are required to submit to this office within thirty days of the date of this Notice a written statement or explanation in reply, including for each item of noncompliance: (1) corrective action taken and the results achieved; (2) corrective action to be taken to avoid further noncompliance; and (3) the date when full compliance will be achieved. Consideration may be given to extending your response time for good cause shown.
