Dear Mr. Lashley:

Enclosed is Amendment No. 12 to your NRC Materials License No. 21-02335-09, in accordance with your request. Please note that former License Condition 23 (restricting possession limits of licensed material) has been deleted from your license because License Condition 8.A. now includes a possession limit. This possession limit is based on your request following our telephone conversation May 8, 2007, in accord with NRC policy, in support of security issues. This amendment also includes some minor modifications to License Condition 13.F., involving leak test criteria, in accord with our current standard conditions. Please note that the changes made to your license are printed in **bold** font.

Please review the enclosed documents carefully and be sure that you understand all conditions. If there are any errors or questions, please notify the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Region III office at (630) 829-9887 so that we can provide appropriate corrections and answers.

You will be periodically inspected by NRC. Failure to conduct your program in accordance with NRC regulations, license conditions, and representations made in your license application and supplemental correspondence with NRC will result in enforcement action against you. This could include issuance of a notice of violation, or imposition of a civil penalty, or an order suspending, modifying or revoking your license as specified in the General Statement of Policy and Procedure for NRC Enforcement Actions. Since serious consequences to employees and the public can result from failure to comply with NRC requirements, prompt and vigorous enforcement action will be taken when dealing with licensees who do not achieve the necessary meticulous attention to detail and the high standard of compliance which NRC expects of its licensees.
