SUBJECT: INFORMATION NEEDED FOR CHANGE OF OWNERSHIP

This is in response to your letter dated February 7, 2007, regarding a change in the name on NRC License No. 49-26861-01. The regulations under 10 CFR 30.34(b) states that "no license issued or granted pursuant to the regulations...nor any right under a license shall be transferred, assigned or in any manner disposed of, either voluntarily or involuntarily, directly or indirectly, through transfer or control of any license to any person, unless the Commission shall...find that the transfer is in accordance with the provisions of the Act and shall give its consent in writing." A notification to the NRC must include a complete, clear description of the transaction that will enable legal counsel to differentiate between name changes and actual changes of control. In all cases, determining whether a transfer of control has taken place is the NRC's responsibility.

Control of a license is in the hands of the person or persons who are empowered to decide when and how that license will be used. That control is to be found in the person or persons who, because of ownership or authority explicitly delegated by the owners, possess the power to determine corporate policy and thus the direction of the activities under the license. A transferee is an entity that proposes to purchase or otherwise gain control of an NRC-licensed operation. A transferor is an NRC licensee selling or otherwise giving up control of a licensed operation.

In order to process your request for a change of control/ownership and/or a name change, the information on the following pages is required. Please provide this information so we may review the information to ensure that the name change is in accordance with the regulations. If any items are not applicable, so state.
