

MEETING REPORT

PURPOSE: Sidebar meeting with COGEMA Mining, Inc., and Pathfinder Mines Corporation to discuss status of projects.

ATTENDEES: See attached Attendance List.

BACKGROUND: COGEMA Mining, Inc. (COGEMA) and Pathfinder Mines Corporation (PMC) have been discussing potential new projects and restarts with Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff. PMC has also been decommissioning and reclaiming its tailings impoundment at Shirley Basin.

DISCUSSION: After all participants were introduced, COGEMA/PMC began its presentation by discussing the status of the Irigaray/Christensen Ranch facility. Old plant equipment has been removed from the Irigaray facility. Plugging and abandonment is proceeding at Irigaray with 50 percent of the well heads removed, and 90 percent of all the pipelines have been removed as well.

Regarding Christensen Ranch, COGEMA submitted a license amendment request to restart this facility. The license amendment is to reinsert all the operating license conditions as they were before the NRC amended its license for standby status. NRC staff has not determined whether this action will be categorically excluded or will require an environmental assessment. COGEMA also performed a test decommissioning at mine unit MU 6-3.

Most of the tailings reclamation at Shirley Basin has been completed, and PMC is currently grading the ore pad and the radon barrier. PMC revised the main channel and completed it at its own risk. It will address the main channel in a separate submittal. At this point in time, PMC is not sure when license termination would be because it would like to mine a nearby ore trend.

The Fab trend is adjacent, but outside, the Shirley Basin boundary. PMC would like to mine this trend, using *in-situ* recovery (ISR) techniques.

PMC stated that it intends to send the resin to Irigaray; however it needs to know which license requires an amendment.
