PURPOSE: Sidebar meeting to discuss the status of Ur-Energy USA, Inc.'s Lost Creek and Lost Soldier applications

BACKGROUND: Ur-Energy USA, Inc. (Ur-Energy) is a potential applicant for *in-situ* leach (ISL) uranium recovery facilities in the Great Divide Basin of Wyoming.

DISCUSSION: After all participants were introduced, Ur-Energy showed a PowerPoint presentation of the progress it has made in compiling applications (attached to report). This was our sixth quarterly meeting. Ur-Energy completed all baseline studies scheduled for 2006 and completed its four quarters of groundwater sampling in 2007. It also will complete soil surveys and bioassays in 2007.

Ur-Energy stated that it will elute resin at its Lost Creek site, but will ship the yellowcake slurry offsite for final processing. An application for Lost Creek will likely be submitted by September 2007. Regarding the application, NRC agreed that three hard copies were sufficient; however, NRC staff would review the submission requirements to be sure. An application for the Lost Soldier site will be submitted in mid-FY08.
