Please note that we were unable to complete your request to add Dr. Ammaturo as Radiation Safety Officer because you did not supply the additional information as requested, i.e. written attestation by a Radiation Safety Officer as required in 10 CFR 35.50 (d), and documentation of training in radiation safety, regulatory issues, and emergency procedures for the types of use authorized on the license, as required by 10 CFR 35.50 (e). Please review the enclosed document carefully and be sure that you understand all conditions. If there are any errors or questions, please notify the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Region I Office, Licensing Assistance Team, (610) 337-5239, so that we can provide appropriate corrections and answers.

You will be periodically inspected by the NRC. Failure to conduct your program safely and in accordance with NRC regulations, license conditions, and the representations made in your license application and supplemental correspondence with NRC will result in enforcement action against you. This could include issuance of a notice of violation, imposition of a civil penalty, or an order suspending, modifying or revoking your license.

An environmental assessment for this action is not required, since this action is categorically excluded under 10 CFR 51.22(c)(14).
