The purpose of this letter is to submit the twenty-second revision of the Cooper Nuclear Station (CNS) Updated Safety Analysis Report (USAR) (Enclosure 1), in accordance with the provisions of 10 CFR 50.71(e). This revision reflects changes made during the time period from June 1, 2005, through March 14, 2007.

As recommended by Nuclear Energy Institute (NEI) 98-03, Revision 1, "Guidelines for Updating Final Safety Analysis Reports," a summary listing of USAR deletions made during this reporting period is included with this submittal (Enclosure 2).

The following documents are incorporated in the USAR by reference; therefore, revisions made to these documents during this reporting period are provided in accordance with the provisions of 10 CFR 50.71(e):

- Inservice Inspection Program for Cooper Nuclear Station

Also included is a listing of each controlled station drawing incorporated in the USAR by reference that has been revised during this reporting period, as well as a copy of each revised drawing (Enclosure 7). USAR Table I-3-1 provides a complete listing of the drawings incorporated by reference and the current revision number of each drawing.

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In accordance with NEI 99-04, Revision 0, "Guidelines for Managing NRC Commitment Changes," a summary of commitment changes made during this reporting period is provided in Enclosure 8.

Pursuant to the requirements of 10 CFR 50.4, we are enclosing one signed original and transmitting copies to the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) Regional Office and the NRC Resident Inspector for CNS.
