‘Plant Performance 2006’

- ✓ Operated Safely and Reliably in 2006
 - Achieved 4 million hours without a lost time accident
 - Capacity Factor – 94.7%
 - Safe and successful completion of two refueling outages

‘2007 Focus Areas’

- ✓ Safety
- ✓ Training
- ✓ Employee Radiological Exposure
- ✓ Equipment Reliability

‘Tritium Remediation’

- ✓ Remediation efforts are working - concentrations reduced by 87%
 - Exelon and Will County have sampled area drinking water wells and all are substantially below the U.S EPA safe drinking water limits
 - Releases posed no health or safety hazard – confirmed by Agency for Toxic Substances and Disease Registry report (requested by U.S. Sen. Dick Durbin), Illinois Department of Public Health, Will County Health Department and NRC
 - Committed to keeping the public informed

‘Supporting the Community’

- ✓ **Exelon is a member of the community**
- ✓ **Contributions and donations in 2006:**
 - **\$11.5 million for the Village of Godley to purchase a new water system**
 - **Employees donated \$211,000 to the United Way**
 - **Fishing for a Cure raised over \$20,000 for Make-a-Wish of Illinois**
 - **Supported Braidwood Family Care (local food bank)**
 - **Sponsored Braidwood Shootout (high school basketball tournament) and Braidwood SummerFest Fireworks**
