Summary: 11:50 I left a message on Mr. Sebia's voice-mail for him to get back in touch with me about the lost device in NY.

15:20 Mr. Sebia returned my call. I read the information that was provided to us by Kevin Snyder and Mr. Sebia stated that he did not have any responsibility for the site. He provided the phone number for Mr. Snyder so that I could speak with him (610-481-6238).

15:30 I spoke with Mr. Snyder. He indicated that the NRC Operations Officer told him that the issue was under the jurisdiction of New York State. Mr. Snyder submitted a report to representatives from New York State informing them that the generally-licensed device had not been found (and, as yet, has not been found on the current date). The facility was located in Glenmont, NY. The licensee performed the following actions to prevent recurrence: (1) Provided training in all of the general license provisions to all users of the devices, (2) Committed to periodic retraining of individuals in the provisions, (3) Updated written instructions, and (4) Establishing a quarterly inventory of all devices containing radioactive material.
