SUBJECT: ALLEGATION TRAINING

Dear Lt. Col. Wrobel,

One of the elements which will be addressed as part of the license renewal process is the handling of allegations. The handling of allegations will be a shared responsibility between the U.S. Air Force and the NRC, which will be documented in the *Letter of Understanding*. NUREG-1556, Volume 10 provides guidance for this element and requires that procedures be available for handling and documenting employees concerns, including a description of the training that will be provided to all employees to ensure they understand their right to contact the NRC directly about radiation safety or regulatory issues.

Enclosed is a disk containing the annual allegation training that NRC employees are required to watch as part of their continued self-study. The Office of Enforcement makes this training available on the NRC intranet so employees may use as part of their self-study. This is being provided for your review and use as you deem appropriate.

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.390 of the NRC's "Rules of Practice," a copy of this letter will be available electronically for public inspection in the NRC Public Document Room or from the NRC's document system (ADAMS).
