Item 10 – Radiation Safety Program

We will either possess and use, or have access to and use, a radiation safety meter that meets the Criteria in the section entitled “Radiation Safety Program – Instruments” in NUREG-1556, Vol. 1, Rev. 1, dated November 2001.

Physical inventories will be conducted at intervals not to exceed six months, to account for all sealed sources and devices received and possessed under the license.

We will maintain, for inspection by the NRC, documentation demonstrating that unmonitored individuals are not likely to receive a radiation dose in excess of ten percent of the allowable limits in 10 CFR Part 20.

We will implement and maintain the operating and emergency procedures in Appendix H of NUREG 1556, Vol. 1, Rev. 1, dated November 2006, and provide copies of these procedures to all gauge users and at each job site.

Leak tests will be performed at intervals approved by the NRC or Agreement State and specified in the Sealed Source and Device Registration Sheet. Leak tests will be performed by an organization authorized by the NRC or an Agreement State to provide leak detection services for other licensees or using a leak test kit supplied by an organization authorized by the NRC or an Agreement State to provide leak test kits to other licensees and according to the kit supplier’s

instructions. The leak test shall be capable of detecting the presence of .005 microcurie of radioactive material on the test sample. The test shall be taken from the surfaces of the device in which the foil is mounted or stored on which one might expect contamination to accumulate. Records of the leak test results shall be kept in units of microcuries and maintained for inspection by the Department. If the test reveals the presence of .005 microcurie or more of removable contamination, the licensee shall immediately withdraw from use and shall cause it to be decontaminated and repaired or to be disposed of in accordance with department regulations.

We will implement and maintain procedures for routine maintenance of our gauges according to the manufacture's recommendations and instructions.

We will send the gauge to the manufacturer or other person authorized by the NRC or an Agreement State to perform non-routine maintenance or repair operations that require the removal of the source from the gauge.
