This letter concerns our application for renewal of By-Product License 47-00260-06, dated February 15, 1979. We wish to clarify two items on the application.

First, in addition to using licensed material at our Technical Center, we wish to use licensed material at temporary job sites of the licensee anywhere in the United States where the USNRC maintains jurisdiction for regulating the use of by-product material. This condition does not prohibit use in agreement states [as defined in 10 CFR 30.4(c)] under reciprocity procedures which may be established by those states.

The second item concerns the use of Krypton-85. In March of 1976, we received Amendment No. 30, authorizing us to possess up to 100 curies of Kr-85 as gas for development of gas transfer and loading techniques and transfer to specifically licensed persons. We have since deleted this activity from our business, and possess only a small amount of Kr-85 that will be disposed of shortly.
