

In accordance with letter dated August 16, 1984, License Number 47-00260-02 is amended as follows:

To add:

- Pursuant to Sections 20.106(b) and 20.302, 10 CFR 20, and letter dated August 16, 1984, the licensee is authorized to dispose of up to 10 millicuries of hydrogen 3 in the form of tritiated water by incineration provided the gaseous effluent from incineration does not exceed the limits specified for air in Appendix B, Table II, 10 CFR 20. Ash residues may be disposed of as ordinary waste provided appropriate surveys pursuant to Section 20.201 are made to determine that concentrations of licensed material appearing in the ash residues do not exceed the concentrations (in terms of microcuries per gram) specified for water in Appendix B, Table II, 10 CFR 20.
