You are hereby granted reciprocal recognition of your NRC License No. 47-00260-02 for conducting activities using radiation sources in the State of Texas, pursuant to Texas Regulations for Control of Radiation (TRCR) 41.90 or 42.10. Your attention is directed to Parts 11, 21 and 41 of the TRCR. This reciprocal recognition will expire February 28, 1993, unless prior notification has been received. However, you are required to notify this Bureau by the filing of a TRC Form 41-1 at least three (3) days prior to each entry into Texas. If at any time you establish a permanent office, or site in Texas, you are required to apply for a Texas Radioactive Material License or Registration Certificate.
