In accordance with letter dated December 3, 1991, License No. 47-00260-02 is amended as follows:

22. Except as specifically provided otherwise in this license, the licensee shall conduct its program in accordance with the statements, representations, and procedures contained in the documents including any enclosures, listed below. The Nuclear Regulatory Commission's regulations shall govern unless the statements, representations and procedures in the licensee's application and correspondence are more restrictive than the regulations.

C. Technical Center Radiological Control Manual, Revised July, 1989

Condition 23. is added as follows:

23. Pursuant to 10 CFR 20.106(b) and 20.302, and in reliance upon information contained in letters dated December 3, 1991 and May 12, 1992, the licensee is authorized to dispose of carbon 14 by incineration provided the gaseous effluent from incineration does not exceed the limits specified for air in Appendix B., Table II, 10 CFR Part 20.
