Mr. Potter,

Union Carbide Corporation is currently intending to sell its OrganoSilicon (OSi) Business, with a closing date now scheduled for June 30, 1993. This sell includes the plant in Sistersville which currently holds U.S NRC materials license number 47-06067-03.

I spoke over the telephone with Mr. Earl G. Wright today, and he indicated that the new owner of the Sistersville Plant would most likely have to apply for a new materials license, although the possibility of amending our current license to reflect the new business name may exist. Attached is a copy of a press release describing the details of the transaction between Union Carbide and the new owner. Mr. Wright asked me to write this letter to you so that a decision could be made concerning a new or amended materials license.

A bridging agreement between Union Carbide and the new owner that will be established at the date of closing, and last for a maximum of one year thereafter, includes Radioactive source services provided to the Plant by Union Carbide under License Number 47-00260-02.

Please provide direction concerning the appropriate mechanism for license transfer in this situation. Also, would you send the necessary forms to complete the transfer or let me know where they may be obtained. My phone number is (304) 652-3211, extension 521.
