

Mr. Sealey called 3/24/70.

I pointed out that the facilities, equipment, and radiation protection program described in their 3/9/70

application appeared to have no connection with their request for field use of neutron sources. He agreed.

I informed him that Pu 239 is special nuclear material, not byproduct material. He responded that they had no current plans to obtain a Pu 239 source, but had included it in the application in case they might some day decide they would like to purchase one.

Mr. Sealey suggested that he send in a new application rather than attempt to modify the 3/9/70 application.
