Below is a brief update on the progress at Safety Light and attached are photos from the last shipment.

A brief summary activities to date include the transfer of material to WCS, TX for storage as follows: 3 tractor trailer box trucks received at WCS without incident, totals for the shipments are 177 - 85 gallon drum over packs, volume of waste 1937 cubic feet, and the curie content is estimated as 4.195 curies.

There are the 3 B-25 boxes that still require attention as well as the additional 49 (estimated) drums identified. The following is a brief summary of the drums and B-25 boxes remaining after the removal of the 177 silo defuse waste shipment campaign;

25 drums - DAW (potential ES direct disposal)
9 drums - liquid which will require sampling (potential ES direct disposal)
4 drums of IDW/DAW - require assessment (potential ES direct disposal) 10 2R
type drums - 5 marker as empty and others marked as Cs (require assessment)
1 drum - material donated from SLC operational buildings (require assessment
and potential inclusion into other like containers)
2 30 gal poly drums - 1 foils 1 markers (require assessment and potential
inclusion into other like containers)

3 B25 Boxes

1 - DAW (potential ES direct disposal)
2 - markers and foils within 13 individual 30 gallon poly drums (require
assessment)

I am in the process of modifying the existing contract to address the
assessment and short term storage of the remaining material within the silo
waste structure. After we have the necessary information we will determine
the best approach to move forward.
