This letter and the enclosed NRC Form 591M refer to the inspection conducted on May 8, 2007, at your facility located in Oka, Tamuning, Guam. The inspection was an examination of activities conducted under your license as they relate to radiation safety and to compliance with the Commission's rules and regulations and with the conditions of your license. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, independent measurements, and observation of activities in progress. A preliminary briefing discussing the inspection results were discussed with you and members of your staff at the conclusion of the inspection. A final exit briefing was conducted with Radiology Director, Nelson Rodriguez, on June 11, 2007.

Within the scope of this inspection no violations or deviations were identified, therefore, no response to this letter or the enclosed NRC form 591M is required.
