Enclosed is Amendment No. 21 to your NRC Material License No. 21-00644-03 in accordance with your request, involving in part, the notification of the business relationship between Chrysler Corporation and DaimlerChrysler and the associated name change needed on the NRC license. Please note that the changes made to your license are printed in **bold** font.

Please review the enclosed document carefully and be sure that you understand all conditions. If there are any errors or questions, please notify the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Region III office at (630) 829-9887 so that we can provide appropriate corrections and answers.

Please be advised that your license expires at the end of the day, in the month, and year stated in the license. Unless your license has been terminated, you must conduct your program involving byproduct materials in accordance with the conditions of your NRC license, representations made in your license application, and NRC regulations. In particular, note that you must:

1. Operate in accordance with NRC regulations 10 CFR Part 19, "Notices, Instructions and Reports to Workers; Inspections," 10 CFR Part 20, "Standards for Protection Against Radiation," and other applicable regulations.
2. Notify NRC, in writing, within 30 days:
 - a. When the Radiation Safety Officer permanently discontinues performance of duties under the license or has a name change; or
 - b. When the mailing address listed on the license changes.
3. In accordance with 10 CFR 30.36(b) and/or license condition, notify NRC, promptly, in writing, and request termination of the license:
 - a. When you decide to terminate all activities involving materials authorized under the license; or
 - b. If you decide not to complete the facility, acquire equipment, or possess and use authorized material.

4. Request and obtain a license amendment before you:
 - a. Change Radiation Safety Officers;
 - b. Order byproduct material in excess of the amount, or radionuclide, or form different than authorized on the license;
 - c. Add or change the areas of use or address or addresses of use identified in the license application or on the license; or
 - d. Change ownership of your organization.
5. Submit a complete renewal application or termination request at least 30 days before the expiration date of your license. You will receive a reminder notice approximately 90 days before the expiration date. Possession of byproduct material after your license expires is a violation of NRC regulations. A license will not normally be renewed, except on a case-by-case basis, in instances where licensed material has never been possessed or used.

In addition, please note that NRC Form 313 requires the applicant, by his/her signature, to verify that the applicant understands that all statements contained in the application are true and correct to the best of the applicant's knowledge. The signatory for the application should be the licensee or certifying official rather than a consultant.

You will be periodically inspected by NRC. Failure to conduct your program in accordance with NRC regulations, license conditions, and representations made in your license application and supplemental correspondence with NRC will result in enforcement action against you. This could include issuance of a notice of violation, or imposition of a civil penalty, or an order suspending, modifying or revoking your license as specified in the General Statement of Policy and Procedure for NRC Enforcement Actions. Since serious consequences to employees and the public can result from failure to comply with NRC requirements, prompt and vigorous enforcement action will be taken when dealing with licensees who do not achieve the necessary meticulous attention to detail and the high standard of compliance which NRC expects of its licensees.

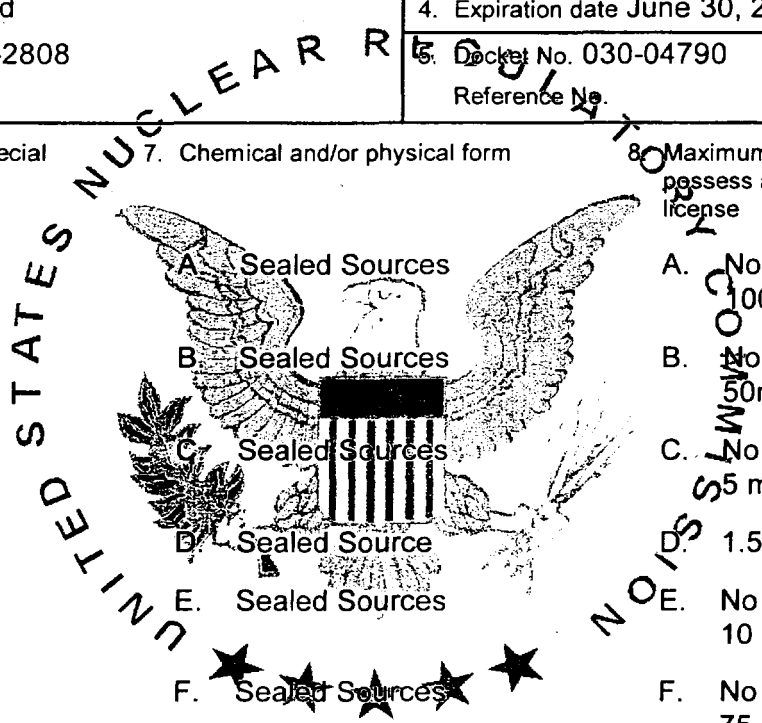



- 10. Licensed material shall be used only at Chrysler Corporation facilities and plants located anywhere in the United States where the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission maintains jurisdiction for regulating the use of licensed material.
 - 11. Radiation Safety Officer: John J. Hartwig
 - 12. Licensed material shall only be used by, or under the supervision of individuals who have received the training described in application dated April 4, 1989, and have been approved in writing by the Radiation Safety Officer.
 - 13.
 - A. Sealed sources and detector cells shall be tested for leakage and/or contamination at intervals not to exceed 6 months or at such other intervals as specified by the certificate of registration referred to in 10 CFR 32.210.
 - B. Notwithstanding Paragraph A of this Condition, sealed sources designed to emit alpha particles shall be tested for leakage and/or contamination at intervals not to exceed 3 months.
 - C. In the absence of a certificate from a transferor indicating that a leak test has been made within 6 months prior to the transfer, a sealed source or detector cell received from another person shall not be put into use until tested.
 - D. Sealed sources need not be leak tested if:
 - (i) they contain only hydrogen-3; or
 - (ii) they contain only a radioactive gas; or
 - (iii) the half-life of the isotope is 30 days or less; or

- (iv) they contain not more than 100 microcuries of beta and/or gamma emitting material or not more than 10 microcuries of alpha emitting material; or
- (v) they are not designed to emit alpha particles, are in storage, and are not being used. However, when they are removed from storage for use or transferred to another person, and have not been tested within the required leak test interval, they shall be tested before use or transfer. No sealed source or detector cell shall be stored for a period of more than 10 years without being tested for leakage and/or contamination.
- E. The leak test shall be capable of detecting the presence of 0.005 microcurie of radioactive material on the test sample. If the test reveals the presence of 0.005 microcurie or more of removable contamination, a report shall be filed with the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission in accordance with 10 CFR 30.50(b)(2), and the source shall be removed immediately from service and decontaminated, repaired, or disposed of in accordance with Commission regulations. The report shall be filed within 5 days of the date the leak test result is known with the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Region III, ATTN: Chief, Nuclear Materials Safety Branch, 801 Warrenville Road, Lisle, Illinois 60532-4351. The report shall specify the source involved, the test results, and corrective action taken.
- F. Tests for leakage and/or contamination shall be performed by the licensee or by other persons specifically licensed by the Commission or an Agreement State to perform such services.
14. Sealed sources containing licensed material shall not be opened or removed from their respective source holders by the licensee.
15. The licensee shall conduct a physical inventory every 6 months to account for all sources and/or devices received and possessed under the license.
16. Maintenance, repair, cleaning, replacement, and disposal of foils contained in detector cells shall be performed only by the device manufacturer or other persons specifically authorized by the Commission or an Agreement State to perform such services.
17. Installation, removal from service, relocation and radiation surveys of the devices containing licensed material listed in Subitems 6.F., 6.G. and 6.I. shall be performed by the device manufacturer or by other persons specifically authorized by the Commission or an Agreement State to perform such services. Notwithstanding the above, these services may also be performed by, or under the supervision and in the physical presence of, Daryl N. James. In performing or supervising these operations, Mr. James shall:
- A. Receive detailed safety instructions from the device manufacturers' representative authorized to conduct training, and have available for reference a copy of the device manufacturers instructions for each operation authorized by this condition.

- B. Verify by visual inspection and radiation survey that the device is fully secured in the shielded position.
- C. Perform a radiation survey before, during and after each operation authorized by this condition for the purpose of verifying that the source is properly shielded and/or installed for operational use.
- D. Verify that the survey meter used is operable, capable of detecting radiation levels generated by the unshielded source and calibrated in accordance with procedures specified in application dated July 15, 1983.
18. Detector cells containing licensed material shall not be opened or the sources removed from the detector cell by the licensee.
19. Except as otherwise specified in this license, the licensee shall have available and follow the instructions contained in the manufacturer's instruction manual for the chromatography device.
20. The licensee shall operate each gauge within the manufacturer's specified environmental limits such that the shielding and shutter mechanism of the source holder is not compromised.
21. The licensee shall assure that the shutter mechanism is locked in the closed position during periods when a portion of an individual's body may be subject to the direct radiation beam. The licensee shall review and modify as appropriate its "lock-out" procedures whenever a new gauge is obtained to incorporate the device manufacturer's recommendations.
22. Each gauge shall be tested for the proper operation of the on-off mechanism and indicator, if any, at no longer than 6-month intervals, or at such longer intervals as specified by the manufacturer and approved by NRC.
23. In addition to the possession limits in Item 8, the licensee shall further restrict the possession of licensed material to quantities below the minimum limit specified in 10 CFR 30.35(d) for establishing decommissioning financial assurance.
24. Except as specifically provided otherwise in this license, the licensee shall conduct its program in accordance with the statements, representations, and procedures contained in the documents, including any enclosures, listed below. The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission's regulations shall govern unless the statements, representations, and procedures in the licensee's application and correspondence are more restrictive than the regulations.

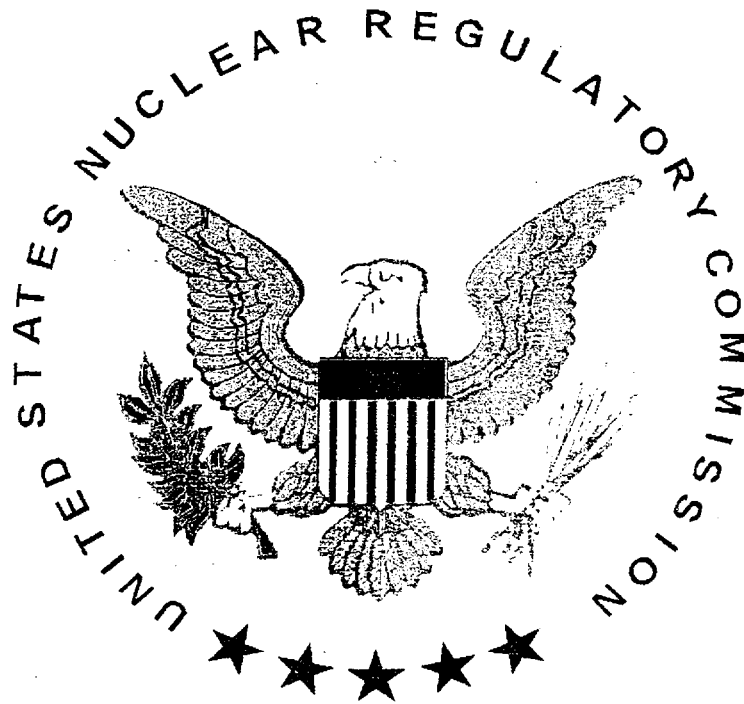
