On April 16, 2007, Louisiana Energy Services National Enrichment Facility (LES) submitted for your review the document titled, *Final Results for Treatment of Cultural Resources Associated with the National Enrichment Facility near Eunice, Lea County, New Mexico*. This report discusses the findings resulting from implementation of the approved Treatment Plan per Stipulation II of the MOA and was submitted to the other signatories and concurring parties for a similar 30-day comment period. LES received 2 responses; the one from the Yselta del Sur Pueblo Tribal Council requesting continued involvement with no comment regarding the report and one from the New Mexico State Historical Preservation Officer stating that "no further information or revisions needs to be provided" accepting the report as final. Since the comments received do not require the report to be revised or amended, the copy of the report submitted to you on April 16, 2007 will suffice as the final report.


