ROY P. ZIMMERMAN  
DIRECTOR, OFFICE OF NUCLEAR SECURITY AND INCIDENT RESPONSE

As Director of the Office of Nuclear Security and Incident Response, Mr. Zimmerman is responsible for developing overall agency policy and providing management direction for evaluation and assessment of technical issues involving security at nuclear facilities. The Office of Nuclear Security and Incident Response develops and oversees the NRC's program for response to incidents and is the agency's security and incident response interface with the Department of Homeland Security, intelligence and law enforcement communities, Department of Energy, Department of Defense and other agencies.

Mr. Zimmerman has 26 years of government service. He joined the NRC's Region I Office in 1978 as a Regional-Based Inspector after leaving GE's Knolls Atomic Power Laboratory as a qualified Engineering Officer of the Watch Training Instructor. He spent approximately 8 years in the Resident Inspector Program, serving as a Resident Inspector at Millstone and a Senior Resident Inspector at Ginna and Palo Verde. In 1992, after a five-year period holding branch and division-level management positions in the NRC's Region IV Office, he relocated to Headquarters. Since that time, Mr. Zimmerman has held a number of increasingly responsible managerial positions, including Division Director, Associate Director, and Deputy Office Director in the Office of Nuclear Reactor Regulation, and Deputy Office Director in the Office of Nuclear Regulatory Research.

Mr. Zimmerman holds a Bachelor of Science degree in Marine (Mechanical) Engineering from the United States Merchant Academy.
