WHEREAS, the Nuclear Regulatory Commission ruled on February 26, 2007, that review of the potential effect of terrorism was not required to be considered in the re-licensing review of the Oyster Creek Nuclear Power Plant; and

WHEREAS, the New Jersey State Department of Environmental Protection has filed a petition with the Third Circuit Court of Appeals, requesting that an analysis of the potential impact of a terrorist attack should be included in the re-licensing review; and


WHEREAS, the recent arrest of six (6) individuals accused of plotting to attack Fort Dix underscores a potential terrorist attack against the Oyster Creek Nuclear Power Plant is more than theoretical,


