To Whom It May Concern:


Please amend the hospital's NRC license as follows:

- 1) Remove Daniel Wujack, M.D., Murray Rothberg, M.D., and Scott Simpson, M.D. from the list of Authorized Users for this license.
- 2) For current Authorized User Joseph Lattanzi, M.D., change the list of byproduct materials he is authorized to use to include those permitted by 10 CFR 35.300, i.e., therapeutic radiopharmaceuticals. Specifically, authorize Dr. Lattanzi for Phosphorus-32, Samarium-153, and Strontium-89 (for those radiopharmaceutical uses approved in 10 CFR 35.300). Additionally, authorize Dr. Lattanzi for both Yttrium-90 and I-131 (therapeutic radiopharmaceuticals permitted by 10 CFR 35.300). This is requested so that Dr. Lattanzi will be authorized to administer either ZEVALIN (Y-90 Ibritumomab Tiuxetan) or BEXXAR (I-131 Tositumomab) to selected patients that may benefit from these therapeutic radiopharmaceutical regimens. Provided for your review as an attachment is a copy of Southern Ocean County Hospital's NRC License (license No. 29-17736-01) that lists Dr. Lattanzi as an Authorized User for therapeutic radiopharmaceuticals, i.e., byproduct materials listed in 10 CFR 35.300 (Phosphorus-32, Samarium-153, and Strontium-89). The use of all authorized therapeutic radiopharmaceuticals shall be in accordance with all applicable license conditions, as well as, NRC regulations.

In an unrelated matter, it is noted that on December 1, 2006 Nucletron Corporation replaced the hospital's "classic" microSelectron HDR unit with their V2 HDR remote afterloading device in accordance with the terms of the hospital's NRC license. Further, at this time Nucletron Corporation also removed the classic microSelectron HDR unit from the hospital. This information regarding this recent upgrade of the HDR unit is being provided as requested.
