By letter dated June 1, 2006, you applied for an amendment to the Perry Nuclear Power Plant Unit No. 1 (Perry), Facility Operating License No. NPF-58. The proposed change would have modified the facility technical specifications (TS) pertaining to TS 3.4.9, "Residual Heat Removal (RHR) Shutdown Cooling System - Hot Shutdown," by adding a Note which suspends actions to be in Mode 4 (Cold Shutdown) to existing Required Action A.3. Subsequently, by letter dated June 19, 2007, you withdrew the amendment request.

The Commission has filed the enclosed Notice of Withdrawal of Application for Amendment to Facility Operating License with the Office of the Federal Register for publication.

AMENDMENT TO FACILITY OPERATING LICENSE

The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (the Commission) has granted the request of FirstEnergy Nuclear Operating Company (the licensee), to withdraw its June 1, 2006, application for proposed amendment to Facility Operating License No. NPF-58 for the Perry Nuclear Power Plant, Unit No. 1, located in Lake County, Ohio.

The proposed amendment would have revised the facility technical specifications (TS) pertaining to TS 3.4.9, "Residual Heat Removal (RHR) Shutdown Cooling System - Hot Shutdown," by adding a Note which suspends actions to be in Mode 4 (Cold Shutdown) to existing Required Action A.3.

The Commission had previously issued a Notice of Consideration of Issuance of Amendment published in the FEDERAL REGISTER on August 15, 2006 (71 FR 46936). However, by letter dated June 19, 2007, the licensee withdrew the proposed change.

For further details with respect to this action, see the application for amendment dated June 1, 2006, and the licensee's letter dated June 19, 2007, which withdrew the application for license amendment.
