Dear Gentlemen/Madams:

We wish to amend our current broad scope license as identified above. The license application form is attached – Amendment No. 33.

It is our intent to add two isotopes to our license: Radium -226 ( $^{226}$ Ra) and Thorium -229 ( $^{229}$ Th). We would like these isotopes to be in any chemical or physical form. The maximum activity to be on hand would be 500 millicuries (18.5 GBq) for  $^{226}$ Ra and 300 millicuries (11.1GBq) for  $^{229}$ Th. These isotopes would be used in the research and development of analytical methods to rapidly qualitatively and quantitatively determine the existence of radioactive material in food.
