The University would like to request that its license be amended to remove Conditions 22.A. and 22.B. with regard to the disposal of licensed material by incineration. The Consumat incinerator (referenced in our license application dated September 29, 1999, and located at the licensed location) has never been used for the incineration of radioactive material. The old incinerator at this location used previously for incineration of small quantities of radioactive material has been out of commission since the mid-1980s. Our decommissioning survey records of this unit are available upon request.
