Attached is the Office of the Inspector General's (OIG) analysis and status of recommendations as discussed in the agency's response dated May 24, 2007. Based on the information provided. Recommendations 1 and 2 remain resolved.

In our May 14, 2007, response to the agency, OIG stated that Recommendations 1 and 2 would be closed when additional changes were made to the agency's websites to reflect the correct superceded status of Management Directives (MD) 2.1 and 2.2. According to the agency's last update, the necessary changes were made on May 16, 2007. However, as of June 21, 2007, the status of MDs 2.1 and 2.2 on NRC's external website is still incorrect and does not mirror the correct "SUPERCEDED" references shown on the agency's internal webpage. Further, both websites should reflect the current approved status of MD 2.8. Recommendations 1 and 2 will be closed once the appropriate corrections to the websites are completed and new MD 2.8 is made publicly available.

Status of Recommendations

Recommendation 1:

Update NRC's management directives to reflect the responsibilities and alignments of the Executive Director for Operations (EDO), the Chief Financial Officer (CFO), and the Chief Information Officer (CIO).

and

Recommendation 2:

Establish a mechanism to ensure that the necessary communication between the CIO and CFO, as required by Office of Management and Budget (OMB) guidance, can occur if the EC is eliminated. Furthermore, current EC responsibilities related to the capital planning and investment control (CPIC) process would need redefinition.

Agency Update Dated May 24, 2007:

In response to your memorandum of May 14, 2006, on the status of open audit recommendations (ML071340278), this provides updated status information for Recommendations 1 and 2 in the Office of the Inspector General's (OIG's) report, "Special Evaluation of the Role and Structure of NRC's Executive Council" (OIG-00-E-09).

On May 16, 2007, changes were made to the NRC's internal and external web sites to reflect the correct status of Management Directive (MD) 2.1, *Information Technology Architecture*, and MD 2.2, *Capital Planning and Investment Control*. Both MD 2.1 and MD 2.2 were superceded by draft new MD 2.8, *Project Management Methodology*, which was issued by the Executive Director for Operations as interim staff guidance in July 2006 pending approval of MD 2.8 for issuance. The NRC staff was advised of this change via NRC Yellow Announcement No. 055 dated August 17, 2006. New MD 2.8 is presently scheduled to be approved by the Chairman for issuance by June 1, 2007.

This completes NRC's actions on OIG-00-E-09.

Status of Recommendations

OIG Analysis:

In our May 14, 2007 response to the agency's February 2007 update, OIG stated that Recommendations 1 and 2 would be closed when the agency's website was revised to reflect the correct status of Management Directives (MD) 2.1 and 2.2, specifically that the two directives were superceded by a new draft MD 2.8.

According to the agency's May 24, 2007 update, the necessary changes were made on May 16, 2007 to NRC's internal and external websites to reflect the correct status of the subject directives. However, as of June 20, 2007, the status of MDs 2.1 and 2.2 on the external website is still incorrect in that it states that the two directives are "Being Revised" (see attachment 1). Furthermore, the references on the external webpage do not mirror the correct language shown on the internal webpage (see attachment 2). OIG also notes that there is no reference to MD 2.8 on the external webpage and the internal webpage needs to reflect that MD 2.8 is no longer draft, interim guidance.

OIG will close Recommendations 1 and 2 when the necessary changes are made to reflect the correct status of MDs 2.1, 2.2, and 2.8.
