Subject: PRM-50-83, Comments on the Petition for Rulemaking Submitted by the Project on Government Oversight and Union of Concerned Scientists (72 Fed. Reg. 14713)

Federal Register Notice 72FR14713 requested public comments on the Petition for Rulemaking Submitted by the Project on Government Oversight and Union of Concerned Scientists. FirstEnergy Nuclear Operating Company (FENOC) appreciates the opportunity to provide comments on this petition for rulemaking as requested by the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) in the Federal Register, dated March 29, 2007.

The Department of Homeland Security (DHS), through Homeland Security Presidential Directive (HSPD)-7, "Critical Infrastructure Identification, Prioritization, and Protection and HSPD-8, "National Preparedness", is responsible for the oversight and coordination of local, state, and federal entities for all terrorist threats including those above the design basis threat, an amendment to 10 CFR 50 is not appropriate. In addition, the NRC and the DHS are already working together to develop and improve emergency preparedness for a terrorist attack through federal initiatives such as comprehensive review programs and integrated response planning efforts. Since these actions are underway, there is no need to initiate new, redundant actions to address this issue.

Therefore, FENOC endorses the comments provided by the Nuclear Energy Institute (NEI) on June 12, 2007, and encourages the NRC to deny the subject rulemaking.
