Dear Mr. Botti:

Enclosed is Amendment No. 07 to your NRC Material License No. 21-32228-01 in accordance with your request. Please note that the changes made to your license are printed in **bold** font.

Please review the enclosed document carefully and be sure that you understand all conditions. If there are any errors or questions, please notify the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Region III office at (630) 829-9887 so that we can provide appropriate corrections and answers.

Please note that we have reformatted Subitem No. 9 at this time to remove all references to excluded authorizations, including but not limited to authorizations such as "generators, xenon-133, aerosols, cardiovascular clinical studies, etc."

Please be reminded, however, that you are still bound by the restrictions imposed by the excluded authorizations contained in documents incorporated into your license in Condition No. 15 of your license.

In addition, I deleted Condition No. 13, as it appeared on Amendment No. 06, because it was no longer appropriate for your licensed program. I added new standard Condition Nos. 13 and 14.

A copy of this letter and its enclosure will be available electronically for public inspection in the NRC Public Document Room or from the Publicly Available Records (PARS) component of NRC's document system (ADAMS). The NRC's document system is accessible from the NRC Web site at <http://www.nrc.gov/reading-rm/adams.html> (the Public Electronic Reading Room).

You will be periodically inspected by NRC. Failure to conduct your program in accordance with NRC regulations, license conditions, and representations made in your license application and supplemental correspondence with NRC will result in enforcement action against you. This could include issuance of a notice of violation, or imposition of a civil penalty, or an order suspending, modifying or revoking your license as specified in the General Statement of Policy and Procedure for NRC Enforcement Actions.
