Dear Mr. Luongo:

Enclosed is Amendment No. 48 to your NRC Material License No. 21-10725-03 in accordance with your request. As a result of the decrease in the possession limit for hydrogen-3, Oakland University is no longer required to have financial assurance. Therefore, we have canceled your financial in the form of a Statement of Intent dated March 25, 1997, in the amount \$750,000, and are returning it for your records.

Please review the enclosed document carefully and be sure that you understand all conditions. If there are any errors or questions, please notify the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Region III office at (630) 829-9887 so that we can provide appropriate corrections and answers.

Please note that by License Condition No. 24 you are required to comply with the "Increased Controls for Licensees that Possess Sources Containing Radioactive Material Quantities of Concern" (IC) (ADAMS Accession No. ML053130364) published as "Attachment B" to the "Orders Imposing Increased Controls" (ML053130218) in the Federal Register on December 1, 2005 (70 FR 72128). This License Condition requires that you complete implementation of said requirements by the first day that radionuclides in quantities of concern are possessed at or above the limits specified in "Table 1: Radionuclides of Concern" found in the IC.


You will be periodically inspected by NRC. Failure to conduct your program in accordance with NRC regulations, license conditions, and representations made in your license application and supplemental correspondence with NRC will result in enforcement action against you. This could include issuance of a notice of violation, or imposition of a civil penalty, or an order suspending, modifying or revoking your license as specified in the General Statement of Policy and Procedure for NRC Enforcement Actions. Since serious consequences to employees and the public can result from failure to comply with NRC requirements, prompt and vigorous enforcement action will be taken when dealing with licensees who do not achieve the necessary meticulous attention to detail and the high standard of compliance which NRC expects of its licensees.

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.390 of the NRC's "Rules of Practice," a copy of this letter will be available electronically in the NRC Public Document Room or from the Publicly Available Records (PARS) component of NRC's document system (ADAMS). The NRC's document
