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2) Physical Description

This shipment consists of 3 x 20' flatracks loaded with 3000 x Gd UO2 rods packed into 18 x Traveller packages, USA/9297/AF-96 Rev1. RADIOACTIVE MATERIAL, Type A Package, Fissile. Total net weight of U is 5,410 kgs. The net weight of U-235 is 270 kgs.

3) Transportation and Route Schedule
