NRC will need to open a pre-licensing Technical Assignment Control (TAC) number to begin charging Strathmore-Roca Honda for NRC staff time related to pre-licensing activities. NRC is a fee recoverable agency and pre-licensing issues and staff time needs to be charged to prospective licensees consistent with 10 CFR 170.12(b)(iii). This will cover staff time for future pre-application consultations and discussions with the company, consultants, and for issues that might be involved in the permitting process. You will be receiving quarterly billing statements, if there are any activities charged to the TAC. Past discussions and meetings will not be charged, only from this point forward.
