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Discussion: Status of Agreement State Program

The Program is keeping NMED up-to-date, and they are continuing to conduct internal reviews of all events. They stated that It now takes them twice as long to do the incident reviews to ensure that they are documenting things thoroughly, and the staff are getting use to reporting incidents into NMED. They requested that a person from the regional office make a site visit. The purpose of the visit would be to identify any potential issues for future IMPEP reviews and provide suggestions to improve the "readability" of the files. Linda McLean said that September might be a good time. A recent email from INL indicated that there were no incomplete NMED records for Texas in their most recent review.

The Program is losing an inspector in the Corpus Christi inspector office; however, they plan to fill the inspector position as soon as possible.

The Program has finished the first year of increased control (IC) inspections, including all field sites. They have had an increase in enforcement cases pertaining to the IC inspections. Many of the licensees have visited the office for meetings.

There has been a reorganization within the two Texas programs. The Texas Commission on Environment Quality (TCEQ) will now be managing the uranium mill program. There has been renewed interest in uranium processing, and new applications have been received for uranium mill sites.

The next quarterly monitoring call is scheduled for September 12 at 9 a.m. CDT.
