The Wyoming Department of Environmental Quality (WDEQ), Water Quality Division (WQD) has reviewed the above referenced reports providing the results of 2006 surface and groundwater sampling and analytical results for the Split Rock Mill Site. We appreciate being included on the mailing list and the opportunity to review this data.

Unfortunately the data provided was only for the two sampling events in 2006, no historic data was provided in order to evaluate any trends in the data. After a brief review of historic well and surface water data from other reports, it did not appear there were any spikes or obvious evidence of contaminant migration. It would be helpful if historic data was included in future reports to aid in the analysis of the data.
