Dear Mr. Weber:

In letters dated March 7, 2007 (Reference 1) and May 18, 2007 (Reference 2), USEC Inc. (USEC) submitted for U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) review and approval security plans to permit telecommunication of classified information through secure data communication devices between approved facilities. In accordance with an agreement between the NRC and the U.S. Department of Energy (DOE), the DOE agreed to act as the Designating Approval Authority (DAA) for USEC classified computer networks. Accordingly, the plans contained within References 1 and 2 were provided to DOE to conduct its review as the DAA. Subsequently, the DOE provided comments on some plans. This letter provides the requested changes to address these comments.

Enclosures 1, 2, and 3 contain USEC Proprietary Information and Security-Related Sensitive Information; therefore, USEC requests that these enclosures be withheld from public disclosure pursuant to 10 *Code of Federal Regulations* (CFR) 2.390(d)(1).
