AUDIT OF NRC'S IMPLEMENTATION OF HOMELAND SECURITY PRESIDENTIAL DIRECTIVE-12 (HSPD-12) (OIG-06-A-20)

Status of Recommendations

Recommendation 6: Formalize the HSPD-12 working group by developing

a charter that defines the membership and

expectations.

Response dated June 26, 2007:

As stated in the December 20, 2006, audit response, the charter will be approved during the first meeting of the Homeland Security Presidential Directive 12 (HSPD-12) Steering Committee and Working Group.

The initial meeting of the HSPD-12 Steering

Committee and Working Group was delayed due to the FY 2007 Continuing Resolution, and then again due to the decision of the U.S. Department of the Interior (DOI) to no longer serve as a Shared Service Provider (SSP). DOI announced on June 18, 2007, that it will no longer offer SSP services to the Federal Government, so the Nuclear Regulatory Commission is in the process of acquiring these services from the General Services Administration (GSA). Once the NRC finalizes the SSP agreement with GSA, the first HSPD-12 Steering Committee and Working Group meeting will be scheduled and the charter will be approved at this meeting. The meeting is anticipated

to take place no later than

August 15, 2007.

OIG Response: The proposed corrective action addresses the intent

of this recommendation. This recommendation will be

closed after OIG reviews the final charter and determines that it defines the group's membership

and expectations.
