Please find enclosed for Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) review, three copies of the *Split Rock Water Storage Ponds Reclamation Construction Completion Report*. Western Nuclear, Inc. (WNI) has completed reclamation of the former groundwater corrective action program (CAP) ponds in accordance with license condition (LC) 74.G, therefore, upon satisfactory review by the NRC, LC 74.G should be deleted from the license.

Please note that in the July 25, 2006 letter from WNI to the NRC (used as the basis for license amendment 100) where WNI proposed the final design for the CAP ponds reclamation, an error was made on the enclosed figure that illustrated the CAP ponds cover configuration. The figure shows a rock mulch layer of 6-inches. The rock mulch layer is actually 4-inches, as specified in the LC 74.G referenced February 7, 1994 approved reclamation plan.

The July 25, 2006 WNI letter to NRC was required to demonstrate the adequacy of the CAP ponds reclamation design to achieve the necessary radon attenuation. The rock mulch layer is not a factor in the radon attenuation calculations. The rock mulch layer is for erosion protection and there have been no changes to the erosion protection design for the CAP ponds since the approval of the February 7, 1994 reclamation plan.
