Dear Mr. Brinkman:

Recently a number of large Cesium-137 sources were purchased for installation at a unit under construction at our Luling, Louisiana plant. Due to circumstances beyond our control this unit cannot be built at our Luling plant and therefore must be located at our Ponce, Puerto Rico plant. Since facilities at Ponce are presently inadequate for storing these sources, we would like to store them at our Technical Center in South Charleston, West Virginia, By Product Material License 47-260-02. We, therefore, respectfully request that you ammend license 47-260-02 to permit the possession of up to 130 curies of Cesium-137 in sealed sources.
