Dear Neighbor:

It is my pleasure to let you know that work at Kaiser Aluminum & Chemical Corporation's thorium remediation project located at 7311 East 41st Street in Tulsa is complete. On December 29, 2006, the U. S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission notified Kaiser that the company has successfully discharged all its obligations with respect to the decommissioning of the Tulsa site, and the site is now released for unrestricted use in the future.

As we began field activity for this project in 2000, our goal was to complete the work safely with as little impact on our neighbors as possible and to maintain compliance with all procedures in our approved Decommissioning Plan. We are pleased the work was performed with no safety incidences and with no exceedences detected in our air monitoring. And in its letter regarding the completion of the project, the NRC informed us that Kaiser has completed all decommissioning activities described in the approved Decommissioning Plan for the site.

We at Kaiser have appreciated the cooperation of all our neighbors, and we thank you for your patience as we completed this extensive construction project.
