Dear Ms. Engstrom:

On July 16-17, 2007, the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) conducted a material control and accounting (MC&A) inspection at your General Atomics TRIGA Reactor Facility. The inspection was conducted under Phase III of Temporary Instruction 2515/154. The enclosed inspection report documents the inspection findings, which were discussed during an exit meeting on July 17, 2007, with Mr. K. Asmussen and other members of your staff.

The inspection examined activities conducted under your license as they relate to safety, security, and compliance with the Commission's rules and regulations and with the conditions of your license. The inspectors reviewed selected procedures and records, observed storage of special nuclear material in the storage canal, and interviewed personnel. Areas examined during the inspection included physical inventory and accounting records.

Based on the results of this inspection, no findings of significance were identified.

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.390 of the NRC's "Rules of Practice," a copy of this letter, will be available electronically for public inspection in the NRC Public Document Room or from the Publicly Available Records (PARS) component of NRC's document system (ADAMS). However, because of the security-related concerns contained in the enclosure, and in accordance with 10 CFR 2.390, this letter's enclosure will not be available for public inspection.
