The purpose of this modification is to: (1) Exercise Option Year One of the contract, thereby extending the period of performance from September 25, 2007 through September 24, 2008; 2) Increase the ceiling amount of the contract by \$117,391.20, from \$113,961.44 to \$231,352.64; and 3) Obligate incremental funding in the amount of \$100,000.00, thereby increasing the obligated amount in the contract from \$113,961.44 to \$213,961.44. Accordingly, the contract is modified as follows:

1. Section B, Subsection B.4, Consideration and Obligation—Fixed Price, is added as follows:

“(a) The total amount of this contract (ceiling) is \$231,352.64.

“(b) The amount presently obligated with respect to this contract is \$213,961.44.”

2. Section F.3, Duration of Contract Period, is deleted and substituted with the following in lieu thereof:

“The contract shall commence on September 25, 2006 and will expire on September 24, 2008. The term of this contract may be extended at the option of the Government for an additional three years.”

A summary of obligations, from the date of award through the date of this modification, is as follows:

This modification obligates fiscal year 2007 funds in the amount of \$100,000.00.

All other terms and conditions of the subject contract remain unchanged.
